## Summer Writer in Residence

Students interested in writing about ecology, natural history, environmental ethics or related topics may apply for the Friends of Lakeside Writer in Residence Scholarship. The scholarship offers a \$1,000 stipend and three-week residency in the natural setting of the Lakeside campus to explore topics and work on writing.

*Iowa Lakeside Laboratory and Regents Resource Center (ILLRRC)* is a field station serving Iowa's state universities. Located on West Lake Okoboji in Northwest Iowa, the Lab provides summer courses and research opportunities for college students and year-round public programs on a 147-acre campus.

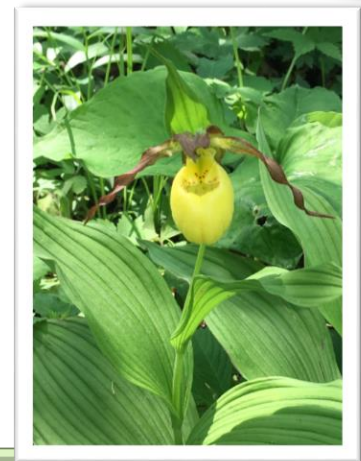
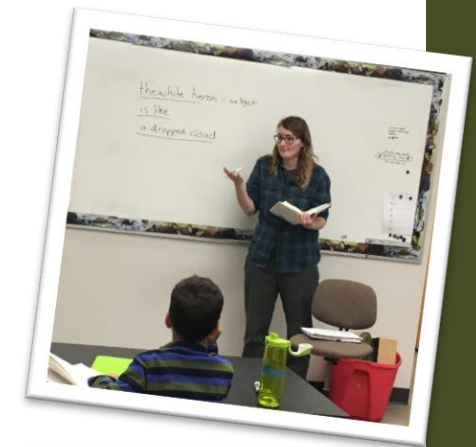
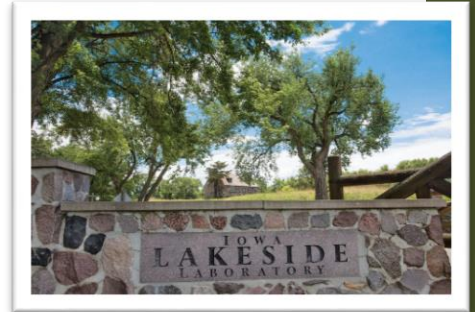

To apply, please submit the following electronically as PDF files to the Friends Executive Director (see below):

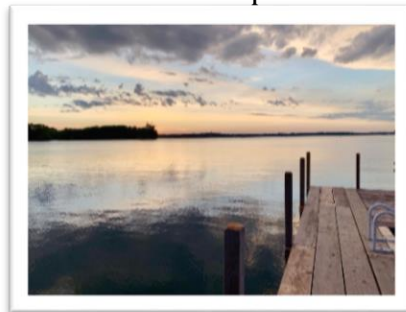
- A letter of application explaining why you are interested in becoming a writer in residence and describing the writing you propose to do while at Lakeside—please also include the preferred dates of your residency
